1. an elf or fairy.

synonyms: fairy, elf, pixie, imp, brownie, puck, peri, goblin, hobgoblin, kelpie, leprechaun, dryad, sylph, naiad; *literary* faerie, fay; *rare* hob, nix, nixie, elfin

2. a computer graphic which may be moved on-screen and otherwise manipulated as a single entity.

3. a faint flash, typically red, sometimes emitted in the upper atmosphere over a thunderstorm owing to the collision of high-energy electrons with air molecules.

Middle English: alteration of *sprit*, a contraction of *spirit*
