Wiktoria Kieniksmán (b. 1998) - graduate of the Academy of Fine Arts in Krakow with a degree in Graphic Arts (2023). Co-founder of the Szaber collective and the Szaber Gallery (founded in 2019). Lives and works in Kraków. As an interdisciplinary artist Kieniksmán explores the themes of evolving self-perception and identity. Her works embrace the transformative influence that confronting societal expectations has on womanhood. She's drawn to places that frown upon taking photos. Her oil paintings and pencil drawings venture into hidden aspects of experiences that cannot be readily documented.

Mikołaj Sobotka (b. 1997) - graduate of the Academy of Fine Arts in Warsaw with a degree in Graphic Arts (2024). Lives and works in Warsaw. Sobotka, mainly working with sculpture and graphic art, deconstructs the concept of still life, addressing the haunting unpleasantness of transience, decay, and exhaustion. The artist does not adhere to a singular theme that encapsulates his expression. His visual language emerges from the belief that meaning is validated by time, and is influenced by various cultural phenomena including manga, baroque art, industrial labels, and product descriptions from AliExpress. His playful sculptural objects often incorporate a mixture of found objects that went through a corrosion process.

Founded by Kamila Fałęcka and Marcelina Gorczyńska, **Turnus** originated in 2020 as an independent artistic and curatorial collective.

Driven by the belief that art thrives in playful, social settings, Turnus transitioned into a permanent space on Warsaw's Wolska Street in June 2023. Evolving beyond a traditional gallery model, its space showcases a vibrant program of exhibitions and events, complemented by a cafe space providing a platform for sociability, neighborly discovery and community building.

Turnus collaborates with emerging voices of contemporary art working across diverse media and experimental practices, such as: Ant Łakomski, Piotrek Kowalski, or Tomek Tofilski.
